How it works ?

- Participants will attend 6 weeks of pre-employment essential skills training including sector specific language development. This is followed by a paid 8 to 12 weeks work placement accompanied by a one on one support.
- There is no financial cost to the employer during the program. Employers will be supported to continue offering language training during participant work placement.

Benefits to employers

- Participants will start their employment immediately following their training.
- Gain access to eligible employees.
- Paid 8 to 12 weeks work placement with no financial cost to the employer.
- Reap the business benefits of diversity.
- Contribute employment opportunities for refugees
